Fasting involves eating one full meal and two smaller meals that don't add up to a full meal. Fasting also involves abstaining from eating between meals. **Abstinence:** Catholics age 14 and older are required to abstain from eating meat on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and all Fridays during Lent.
- **Stations of the Cross** will be said each Friday during Lent. Volunteers are needed to lead the Stations. A signup sheet is at the back of the church.
